

Got 5 minutes, try this.

Socrative - A cloud based free program that allows you to give instructional quizzes remotely and get instant student % class results back , in roll order, without any correcting, at the simple push of a button. Students can use any Electronic Device, Phone, Tablet or Computer to log in as a student.

Pat McMahon has written a few more Socrative Quizzes to share with you (see attached PDF lists), to help you instruct and collect student data ,under the current climate of Remote Teaching.

If you have 5 minutes, Pat has launched and left open, one of his Quizzes, his recently developed “5 Ways to tell the Polarity of an LED”, give it a try.

Below are the simple steps for you to try the quiz, as a student.

1– Search Socrative> Student Log In.

2 - Enter “PATSROOM” as the teachers room, you are invited to complete his quiz on.

3 - Enter your name “Surname, First name”. This ensures your class results in alphabetical roll order.

4 - Complete the quiz, you will get your % result instantly on completion. Pat as the Teacher, will also see your results instantly.

If you find that you could use Socrative, Import some of Pat’s Quizzes listed. You can do this by either the two ways below:-

1 - Open your Socrative Teacher Account, go to Quizzes> +Add Quiz > Import> SOC number> Import Quiz.

2 - Open your Socrative Teacher Account, go to Quizzes > Share> URL > Copy. (see Pat’s URL’s on the supplied PDF)

You can easily create your own Quizzes, go to “Socrative - Support Tutorials” for help. You can see how to set up your own room. I use the free Socrative, not the Socrative Pro, as it has a \$ cost.

Hope this may help you with your Remote Teaching.
